

## Job Posting - Children's Program Afterschool Leader

Kiwassa Neighbourhood House, a multi-service community agency working in East Vancouver, is recruiting Afterschool Leaders to interact directly with children (ages 5-11) in delivering engaging, active, and developmentally appropriate programs.

## Responsibilities:

- Help create and implement age-appropriate activities and culturally safe spaces for children/pre-teens with diverse backgrounds and varying needs
- Adhere to COVID protocols and policies and support children in growing their capacities for COVID adaptations
- Create an inclusive environment where children/pre-teens feel welcomed and supported in their learning and development
- Build positive relationships with participating children/pre-teens and their caregivers
- Track attendance and program statistics
- Work with colleagues and supervisor to provide reflection during debrief sessions, celebrate successes, and work through challenges

## **Experience and skills:**

- You are reliable, patient, enthusiastic, and enjoy working with children and/or pre-teens
- You have an understanding and cultural fluency in working with racialized newcomers and Indigenous families
- You have a creative and energetic approach to engaging children and pre-teens in various learning and play-based activities
- You are familiar with Social Emotional Learning and positive behaviour management practices
- You care about children/pre-teens and are invested in creating engaging learning opportunities for them to thrive
- You have experience working with vulnerable populations and under-resourced children
- You are energetic, have a team ethos and enjoy working with other staff

## **Education:**

- Completion of high school (minimum 19 years of age; post-secondary education/certificate in related field preferred e.g., social sciences, education, child and youth care)
- Responsible Adult certification an asset
- First-Aid and CPR training mandatory
- Trauma informed practice and crisis intervention training an asset
